CEMO also decided to do the solvent recycling on site - and have come down to 4,500 kg of Rhodiasolv RPDE per year.



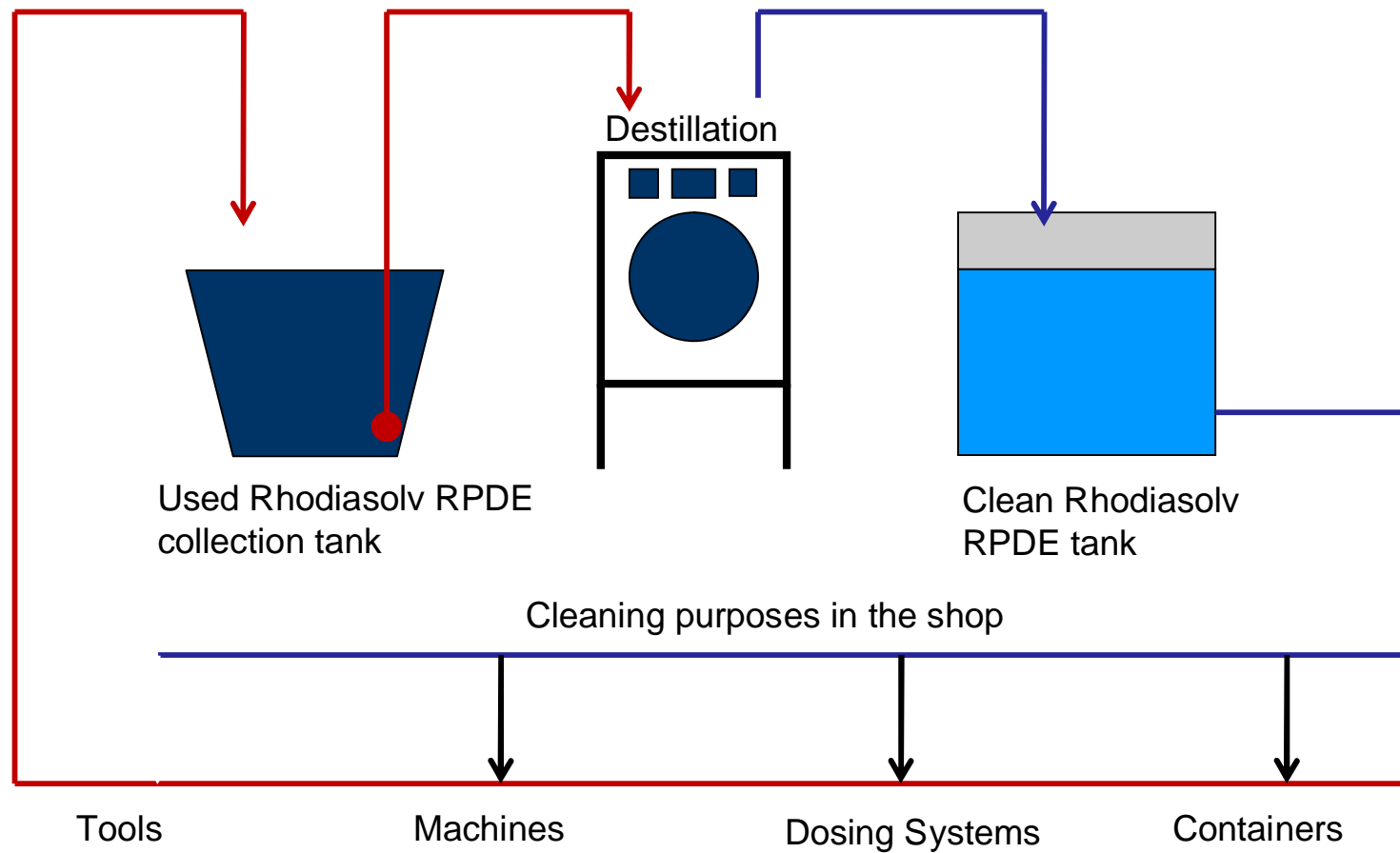
## Award winner
